## HISTORY FACTS

Martin Luther King, Jr. was born on January 15, 1929. The federal holiday honoring him is the third Monday of January. The campaign to honor Dr. King began soon after his assassination in 1968. President Ronald Reagan signed the holiday into law in 1983. It was first observed three years later. Some states first resisted observing the holiday as such, giving it alternative names or combining it with other holidays. It was first observed in all 50 states in 2000.
