5. When people doubt you, how do you respond (28-33)?

6. What convinced David he could defeat Goliath? Of the qualities mentioned what do you need the most in your life (34-37)?

5. What was extraordinary about the friendship between Jonathan and David (12-17)?

5. Knowing that God was with him, David becomes different. How does David change (v.10-12)? If you knew the Lord was with you, how would you be different?
