November 5-6, 2019**

Did you read the entire chapter?

1. **Read 2 Kings 24:18-20.** What was unfortunate about Zedekiah’s legacy? Why is holy, healthy leadership important?

2. What was lacking in Zedekiah’s escape plan (4-7)? Why do you think his sons were singled out for execution (6-7)? If you lost your sight, what would you miss seeing the most?

3. Why were some of the poorest people charged to work the land (12)? What is the meaning of Matthew 5:3

4. What did Nebuchadnezzar look for in a governor over the people left behind in Judah (22-24)? What do you look for in a leader?

5. What does Jehoiachin’s release say about Evil-Merodach? What do you appreciate about mercy?
