Read Nehemiah 6
February 4-5, 2020**

Did you read the entire chapter?

1. What final and new threats does Nehemiah face from his enemies? Why? How does the devil work against us?

2. What is significant about the opposition Nehemiah faces? What are different schemes the enemy uses?

3. What was the intention of the unsealed letter? How does Nehemiah respond? How do you respond to enemy opposition?

4. What was the prophecy of Shemaiah intended to do? How did Nehemiah discern he was a false prophet? How do you discern between the will of God from words of a false prophet?

5. Throughout Nehemiah 6, what does Nehemiah pray for? What’s the content of his prayer(s)? How do Nehemiah’s prayer inform your prayer life?

6. What is significant about the rebuilding of the walls? What miracles have you experienced and/or witnessed? What do miracles do for your faith in God?

7. What are your takeaways from Nehemiah 6?

3. What role do the Levites play in this assembly? Why are they important? Who has helped you understand scripture?

4. In your opinion why can't the people understand the Bible? What does it take to understand the scripture?

5. Once the people understand the scripture, what happens? What do the people discover? How have you responded to really comprehend God and Scripture?

6. What acts do you celebrate? What is the meaning of joy? What impact does joy have among the people?
