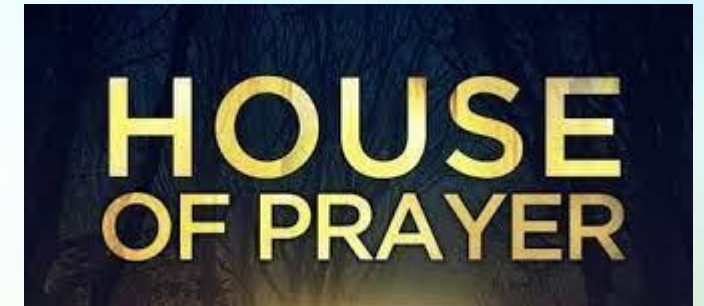
GLOBAL 6K
