3.	<b>Read James 5:7-12.</b> Why do you think James emphasizes patience and perseverance? What examples does James provide to illustrate patience and perseverance? What can we learn from these examples?
4.	<b>Read James 5:13-18</b> . What role should prayer play in the life of a Christian? How does this compare to how we treat the practice of prayer? What do we learn from the example of Elijah as a person of prayer?

<b>Read James 5:19-20</b> . What does James mean by "saving a soul from death" in verses 19-20? How
can we re-engage people who have strayed from the faith?
What are some significant lessons you have learned from the Book of James?
